

This program is designed to:

- develop reading comprehension
 - being able to comprehend a story that has been read to them focusing on the ability to give oral summaries
- enhance focus
 - paying attention
 - sit quietly
 - focus on the teacher
- increase spelling and writing
 - to spell and write name
 - spelling and writing address and phone number
- perfect fine motor skills
 - writing (controlling a pencil, crayon, marker, etc.)
- further identification of
 - colors
 - shapes
- expand phonics (pronunciation) skills
 - sounds of letters in the alphabet
 - identification of beginning and ending sounds
- develop simple math concepts
 - addition, subtraction
 - logic
- increase safety awareness
- advance a child's ability to follow directions
- enrich social growth
 - being respectful to teachers
 - being respectful to classmates
- improve homework habits
 - ages 6 and higher only

Class Duration

- each session is one hour and thirty minutes long.

Class Frequency

- Monday through Friday
 - 10am -11:30am
 - 1pm - 2:30pm
- You may sign up for 2 to 5 classes per week.
- Recommendation:
 - Age 3: minimum 2 days, maximum 5 days per week
 - Age 4: minimum 3 days, maximum 5 days per week
 - Age 5: minimum 3 days, maximum 5 days per week
 - Age 6: minimum 3 days, maximum 5 days per week
 - assumes child is already in Kindergarten but is in need of extra help
- Special one on one tutoring sessions are also available upon request and upon availability

NOTE: One free class/visit for parent and child to observe our instruction is encouraged.
